A B I L L

To enact section 3314.088 of the Revised Code to 1
prohibit community schools from using state funds 2
to hire a lobbyist or for public relations 3
services. 4

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3314.088 of the Revised Code be 5
enacted to read as follows: 6

Sec. 3314.088. (A) As used in this section, "lobby" or 7
"lobbying" means to promote, oppose, or otherwise influence the 8
outcome of federal, state, or local decisions, policies, or 9
legislation by direct communication, including presenting 10
testimony at a hearing, with any person who is an elected 11
executive or legislative official, the director of a federal, 12
state, or local executive or administrative department, or any 13
member of the staff of such an official or department. 14

"Lobbying" does not include either of the following: 15

(1) The action of any person having a direct interest in 16
executive agency decisions who, under Section 3 of Article I, Ohio 17
Constitution, assembles together with other persons to consult for 18

<u>their common good or petitions such a person for the redress of</u>	19
<u>grievances;</u>	20
<u>(2) Contacts made for the sole purpose of gathering</u>	21
<u>information contained in a public record.</u>	22
<u>(B) No community school governing authority, sponsor, or</u>	23
<u>operator shall use state moneys paid to the community school under</u>	24
<u>section 3314.08 of the Revised Code to hire an independent agent</u>	25
<u>to lobby on behalf of the school governing authority, or operator,</u>	26
<u>or to perform public relations services for that school.</u>	27
<u>Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit a</u>	28
<u>member of a community school governing authority or any employee</u>	29
<u>of the community school or operator from lobbying for that school.</u>	30
