## A BILL

To require the Director of Health with assistance
from the Ohio State University Extension Program
to establish and administer a pilot program for
the purpose of reducing infant mortality in
high-risk communities and to make an
appropriation.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. (A) Not later than one month after the effective 7 date of this section, the Director of Health shall establish and administer a pilot program for the purpose of reducing infant 9 mortality in high-risk communities. The pilot program shall be 10 operated for two years. The Director shall select the 11 participating communities, located in five counties, in accordance 12 with the selection process specified in rules adopted under 13 division (F) of this section. 14 (B) The Ohio State University Extension Program shall assist 15

- the Director with the pilot program's administration. To that end, 16
  Extension Program personnel shall do both of the following: 17
- (1) Recruit volunteers in each participating community andtrain them to provide services, tailored to the community's needs,in a culturally sensitive manner;
