issue, returnable before any court or magistrate, for any person	11
to give information concerning such felony the criminal offense.	12
The chief legal officer of a municipal corporation may cause	13
subpoenas to be issued under this section only for the	14
investigation of misdemeanors. The subpoenas shall require the	15
witness to appear forthwith. Before such the witness is required	16
