BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:	
Section 1. That section 2927.12 of the Revised Code be	5
amended to read as follows:	6
Sec. 2927.12. (A) As used in this section, "disability" means	7
a physical, sensory, cognitive, or mental disorder that	8
substantially limits one or more major life activities, including,	9
out not limited to, the functions of caring for one's self,	10
performing manual tasks, walking, seeing, hearing, speaking,	11
oreathing, learning, and working; a record of a physical, sensory,	12
cognitive, or mental disorder; or being regarded as having a	13
physical, sensory, cognitive, or mental disorder.	14
(B) No person shall violate section 2903.21, 2903.22,	15
2909.06, or 2909.07, or division (A)(3), (4), or (5) of section	16
2917.21 of the Revised Code by reason of the race, color,	17
religion, or national origin <u>, or disability</u> of another person or	18
group of persons.	19

(B)(C) Whoever violates this section is guilty of ethnic
