A BILL

To amend sections 1509.99 and 3734.99 and to enact 1 section 1509.16 of the Revised Code to increase criminal penalties for violations of the Oil and 3 Gas Law relating to improper disposal, transport, 4 and management of brine, to establish a criminal 5 penalty for a negligent violation of certain 6 provisions of the Solid, Hazardous, and Infectious Wastes Law, and to require the revocation of a 8 violator's permits and registration certificate 9 and denial of future permit and registration 10 certificate applications under the Oil and Gas 11 12 Law.
