The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 25-Representatives Gibbs, Grendell, Peterson, Seitz, Otterman, McGregor, Core, Gilb.

To amend section 307.37 and to repeal section 4740.14 of the Revised Code to permit counties to include regulations in their building codes to protect existing surface and subsurface drainage, and to eliminate the Residential Construction Advisory Committee.

H. B. No. 26-Representatives Raga, Schneider.

To amend section 2301.02 of the Revised Code to add one additional judge for the general division of the Warren County Court of Common Pleas to be elected in 2004.

Said bills were considered the first time.
