## INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 416**-Representatives C. Evans, Calvert, J. Stewart, DeWine, McGregor, Cates, Williams, Latta, Kearns, Setzer, Hughes, Hollister, Hartnett, Reidelbach, Husted, Gibbs, Willamowski, Schaffer, Schmidt, Seitz, Allen, Perry, D. Evans, Widener, Chandler, Otterman, Skindell, Seaver, Key, Webster, Flowers, Harwood, Strahorn, Walcher.

To enact section 5533.62 of the Revised Code to designate the portion of United States Route 35 within Gallia County the "Bob Evans Highway."

## H. B. No. 417-Representative DeGeeter.

To amend section 2907.322 of the Revised Code to allow a trier of fact in a prosecution for pandering sexually oriented matter involving a minor to consider digital images, computer images, or computer-generated images as visual representations of a minor.

**H. B. No. 418**-Representatives Wolpert, Peterson, Raga, Schaffer, G. Smith, Trakas.

To amend sections 3318.023, 3318.032, 3318.05, 3318.06, 3318.062, and 3318.08 and to enact section 3318.043 of the Revised Code to permit certain school districts experiencing high growth in student enrollment to receive assistance under the Classroom Facilities Assistance Program earlier than they otherwise would be eligible, to eliminate the requirement that such high-growth school districts levy a tax for maintenance of classroom facilities acquired with state assistance, and to reduce the maximum school district share of the cost of any project under the Classroom Facilities Assistance Program to ninety per cent.

Said bills were considered the first time.
