To amend section 4710.01, to enact new sections 4710.02, 4710.03, and 4710.99 and section 4710.04, and to repeal sections 4710.02, 4710.03, and 4710.99 of the Revised Code, relative to engaging in the business of debt adjusting for debtors, to specify contribution limits and auditing and insurance coverage duties, to require timely disbursement of debtor funds, and to provide penalties, including a criminal penalty, for a violation; and to eliminate previous provisions regulating entities engaging in the business of debt pooling.
