INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 446-Representatives Webster, Allen, Brown, Carano, Collier, Combs, Flowers, Husted, Kearns, Otterman, S. Patton, Schaffer, Schmidt, Seitz, Setzer, S. Smith, Strahorn, Wagner.

To amend sections 3517.10, 3517.106, and 3517.11 of the Revised Code to permit candidates for statewide office and candidates for the office of member of the General Assembly to file campaign finance statements by paper, on computer disk, or by electronic means of transmission.

H. B. No. 447-Representatives Carano, Miller, Hollister, Harwood, Perry, Book, Otterman, Distel, Koziura, S. Patton, Strahorn, Seaver, Kearns, Collier.

To amend sections 3314.013, 3314.015, 3314.02, and 3314.17 of the Revised Code to create a two-year moratorium on the establishment of new community schools sponsored by entities other than the school districts in which they would be located, to extend after the moratorium the statewide cap on the number of community schools sponsored by entities other than such school districts, to require training in reporting data to the Education Management Information System for community schools and their sponsors, to increase the penalty for community school fiscal officers who fail to report data as required, and to direct the Legislative Office of Education Oversight to update an existing study of community schools.

H. B. No. 448-Representative Gilb.

To direct that the General Assembly consider proposals to reform Chapters 2151. and 2153. of the Revised Code.

H. B. No. 449-Representatives Seitz, Calvert, Collier, Carano, Aslanides, Webster, Setzer, Buehrer, Clancy, D. Evans, McGregor, Schneider, Gibbs, Slaby, Allen.

To amend sections 145.384 and 145.385 of the Revised Code to allow a retirant re-employed in a position covered by the Public Employees Retirement System to receive a refund of the retirant's contributions in lieu of

a benefit for the period of re-employment.

Said bills were considered the first time.
