INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 452-Representatives Wolpert, Seitz, Hughes, McGregor.

To repeal sections 3901.41, 3901.781, 3901.782, 3901.783, and 3901.784 of the Revised Code to eliminate the requirements that foreign insurance companies annually publish their certificate of compliance in a newspaper in each county where the insurer has an agency and to notify the Superintendent of Insurance of any disciplinary actions taken by other states.

H. B. No. 453-Representatives D. Stewart, Skindell, Price, Harwood, Allen, DeGeeter, Brown, Beatty, Strahorn.

To amend sections 2923.16 and 2923.162 of the Revised Code to prohibit a person from knowingly causing or attempting to cause physical harm to persons or property by discharging a firearm from a motor vehicle or upon or over a public road or highway.

H. B. No. 454-Representatives White, Seitz, Clancy, McGregor, Raga, Schmidt, Setzer, Chandler, Kearns, Schaffer, Webster, Miller, Perry, Distel, Strahorn.

To amend section 3719.81 and to enact section 3719.811 of the Revised Code regarding the distribution of sample drugs by and to charitable pharmacies.

H. B. No. 455-Representative Schneider.

To amend sections 145.384, 145.46, 742.3711, 3307.60, 3309.46, and 5505.162 of the Revised Code regarding an election by a retirant of one of the state's public retirement systems who has married or remarried to change the plan under which a retirement benefit is paid.

Said bills were considered the first time.
