The House met pursuant to adjournment.

Pursuant to House Rule No. 21, the Clerk called the House to order.

Representative G. Smith was selected to preside under the Rule.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 472-Representative Young.

To enact section 5312.01 of the Revised Code to prohibit a residential land trust from assessing fees unless the trustees are elected in accordance with specified statutory procedures.

H. B. No. 473-Representatives Hagan, Seitz, Latta, Hughes, Widowfield, McGregor, Slaby, Carano.

To amend section 2950.05 of the Revised Code to revise the Sex Offender Registration and Notification Law's "change of address" requirements relative to persons who do not have knowledge of a change in residence, school, institution of higher education, or place of employment address sufficiently in advance of the change to comply with the requirements' deadlines and persons whose residence address change is not to a fixed address.

H. B. No. 474-Representative Setzer.

To amend sections 3301.075, 3302.04, 3319.22, 3319.227, and 3319.302 and to enact sections 3312.01, 3312.02, 3312.03, 3312.04, 3312.05, 3312.06, 3312.09, 3312.10, 3312.11, and 3312.14 of the Revised Code to require the State Board of Education to establish the Ohio Regional Education Delivery System by July 1, 2007.

H. B. No. 475-Representatives Setzer, C. Evans, Schaffer, Flowers, Aslanides.

To enact sections 305.031, 503.242, 733.311, and 3311.111 of the Revised Code to provide for the temporary replacement of certain elected officials called to active duty in the armed forces.

H. B. No. 476-Representatives Young, Aslanides, Fessler, Schaffer,

Schmidt, Slaby, Wagner.

To amend sections 2305.234, 4731.05, and 4731.143 and to enact sections 2307.90 to 2307.95 and 4731.37 of the Revised Code to establish an alternative form of dispute resolution for medical malpractice claims against physicians and to amend the version of section 2305.234 of the Revised Code that is scheduled to take effect July 12, 2004, to continue the provisions of this act on and after that effective date.

H. B. No. 477-Representatives Flowers, Collier, Schlichter, Miller, Cirelli, Harwood, Allen, McGregor.

To amend sections 3770.02, 3793.01, and 3793.02 of the Revised Code to require the Director of the State Lottery Commission to enter into an agreement with the Department of Alcohol and Drug Addiction Services for the operation of a program for gambling addiction, to require the Commission to pay for the operation of that program, and to require the Department to provide gambling addiction services.

Said bills were considered the first time.
