The following bill was introduced:

H. B. No. 202-Representatives McGregor, Allen, Carano, C. Evans, Harwood, Hughes, Key, Latta, Miller, Olman, Otterman, Perry, Redfern, Schaffer, Seitz, Ujvagi, Williams.

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 4503.74 of the Revised Code to create "Ohio Zoo" license plates.

Said bill was considered the first time.

I am directed to inform the House of Representatives that the Senate has concurred in the passage of the following bill:

To enact sections 6111.50 to 6111.56 of the Revised Code to establish requirements for the use of credible data in administering the Water Pollution Control Law.

With the following additional amendments in which the concurrence of the House is requested:

Between lines 92 and 93, insert:

"(G) Nothing in sections 6111.50 to 6111.56 of the Revised Code is an exception to statutory, common, or municipal law of trespass."

In line 159, delete the first "and".

In line 162, after "section" insert ", and certify that the person has not been convicted of or pleaded guilty to a violation of section 2911.21 of the Revised Code or a substantially similar municipal ordinance within the previous five years".

In line 172, delete "verify the accuracy of the data,".

In lines 175 and 192, delete "are accurate and".
