INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 524-Representative DeGeeter.

To amend section 2950.99 of the Revised Code to make a violation of the prohibition under the Sex Offender Registration and Notification Law against certain offenders residing within 1,000 feet of any school premises a felony of the fifth degree.

H. B. No. 525-Representatives Latta, Faber, McGregor, Hughes, Slaby, Gilb, Schmidt.

To amend sections 2152.74, 2743.191, and 2901.07 of the Revised Code to require DNA specimen collection from delinquent children and criminal offenders for all felonies.

Said bills were considered the first time.
