INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 246-Representative T. Patton.

To amend sections 124.23 and 124.27 of the Revised Code to modify the percentage of additional credit that may be awarded to qualifying veterans in classified civil service examinations.

H. B. No. 247-Representative T. Patton.

To enact sections 4955.41 to 4955.49 of the Revised Code to authorize the establishment of demonstration railroad quiet zones in specified Ohio cities.
