INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 526-Representatives Trakas, Peterson, Olman, Wolpert, Widowfield.

To amend sections 319.301, 323.17, 718.09, 718.10, 5705.02, 5705.214, 5705.29, 5748.01, 5748.02, 5748.03, 5748.04, and 5748.08 and to enact section 5705.219 of the Revised Code to grant boards of education limited authority to levy additional, voter-approved property taxes that are not subject to the "H.B. 920" revenue growth limitation, to permit school boards to apply school district income taxes only to earnings, to prospectively limit the total rate of school district income taxes to 1%, and to reauthorize joint municipal-school district income taxes.

H. B. No. 527-Representative Wolpert.

To amend sections 3517.10, 3517.103, 3517.104, 3517.106, 3517.11, 3517.13, 3517.152, 3517.153, 3517.154, 3517.155, 3517.20, and 3517.992, to enact new section 3517.102, and to repeal sections 3517.102, 3517.108, 3517.109, and 3517.1010 of the Revised Code to revise the Campaign Finance Law.

Said bills were considered the first time.

On motion of Representative D. Evans, the House adjourned until Thursday, July 15, 2004 at 11:00 o'clock a.m.
