INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced:

H. B. No. 530-Representative J. Stewart.

To enact sections 3301.41, 3313.666, and 3313.667 of the Revised Code to require the Department of Education to develop a model policy prohibiting harassment, intimidation, or bullying; to require each school district board of education to adopt a policy prohibiting harassment, intimidation, or bullying; to provide school district employees, students, and volunteers civil immunity for damage arising from reporting an incident of harassment, intimidation, or bullying; to authorize school districts to form bullying prevention initiatives; and to require school districts to provide training and education on harassment, intimidation, or bullying policies if funds are appropriated for such purposes.

Said bill was considered the first time.
