INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced:

H. B. No. 533-Representatives Harwood, Distel, McGregor, Perry, Carano, Reidelbach, Seitz, Sykes, Sferra, Clancy, Key, Seaver, Redfern, Olman, Beatty, Otterman, Price.

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 4503.491 of the Revised Code to create breast cancer awareness license plates and to provide that money from contributions for the license plates be distributed to the Ohio affiliates of the Susan G. Komen Breast Cancer Foundation and used for breast cancer prevention, detection, treatment, education, and research.

Said bill was considered the first time.
