INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 253-Representatives T. Patton, Setzer, Barrett, Miller.

To enact sections 1753.22 and 3923.72 of the Revised Code relative to coverage for prescription drug services provided by "any willing pharmacies" under policies of sickness and accident insurers and health insuring corporations.

H. B. No. 254-Representative Cirelli.

To amend sections 2307.64 and 4719.99, to amend, for the purpose of adopting a new section number as shown in parentheses, section 2307.64 (4719.45), and to enact sections 4719.46 to 4719.53 of the Revised Code to establish additional requirements regarding electronic mail advertisement transmissions, including residential do-not-e-mail registries, and add enforcement by the Attorney General.

Said bills were considered the first time.
