To amend sections 2913.01 and 2913.02 of the Revised Code to make the penalty for theft of anhydrous ammonia a felony of the third degree.

H. B. No. 537-Representative C. Evans.

To enact section 5533.81 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route Number 588 and Jackson Pike within Gallia County as the "Nehemiah and Permelia Atwood Memorial Highway."
