INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 538-Representatives Skindell, Miller, Carano, Barrett, Allen, Key, S. Smith, Strahorn, Perry, D. Stewart.

To amend section 3715.99 and to enact sections 3715.88, 3715.89, and 3715.90 of the Revised Code to require manufacturers and labelers of dangerous drugs to disclose to the Director of Health the value, nature, and purpose of certain gifts, fees, payments, subsidies, and other economic benefits they provide in connection with pharmaceutical detailing, marketing, or promotion.

H. B. No. 539-Representatives Hartnett, McGregor, Schaffer, Fessler, Redfern, Distel, Webster, Hollister.

To amend section 2329.66 and to enact section 2329.663 of the Revised Code to permit the attachment of retirement accounts in certain situations.

Said bills were considered the first time.
