INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 267-Representative Hughes.

To amend sections 2152.17, 2929.01, and 2929.14 and to enact section 2941.1413 of the Revised Code to enhance the penalty imposed upon an offender or a delinquent child who commits aggravated burglary or burglary between sunset and sunrise and to amend the versions of sections 2929.01 and 2929.14 of the Revised Code that are scheduled to take effect January 1, 2004, to continue the provisions of this act on and after that effective date.

H. B. No. 268-Representatives Grendell, Williams, Reidelbach, Faber, Kearns, Hughes.

To amend section 122.17 and to enact sections 5707.051, 5725.32, and 5729.032 of the Revised Code to extend the job creation tax credit to insurance companies and dealers in intangibles.

Said bills were considered the first time.

On motion of Representative McGregor, the House adjourned until Tuesday, September 2, 2003 at 11:00 o'clock a.m.
