**INTRODUCTION OF BILLS**

The following bill was introduced:

**H. B. No. 545**-Representatives Distel, Redfern, Brown, Key, Bocchieri, Ujvagi.

To amend sections 4737.05, 4737.07, 4737.08, 4737.09, and 4737.10 of the Revised Code to require a scrap material recycling facility to be licensed as a junk yard, to require that all junk yards be in compliance with applicable environmental laws in order to receive and retain a license, and to require junk yards to erect perimeter fencing inside the property line of any adjoining residential property.

Said bill was considered the first time.
