INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 271-Representatives McGregor, Cirelli, Fessler, Grendell, Hughes, Kearns, Latta, Seaver, Schaffer, J. Stewart, Wagner, Webster, Willamowski, Williams.

To amend sections 124.15 and 126.31 and to enact section 141.20 of the Revised Code to limit the salary and employee benefits of certain executives of state agencies and state-assisted entities.

H. B. No. 272-Representatives Seitz, McGregor, Calvert, Fessler, Wolpert, Hoops, Clancy, Schmidt, Willamowski, Schneider, Setzer, Aslanides, Raga, Young, Wagner, Webster, Buehrer, Daniels, Collier, Hagan, Cates, Schaffer, Gilb, Reidelbach, Niehaus, Latta, Seaver, Faber, D. Evans, Flowers, Taylor, Grendell, Brinkman.

To amend section 3101.01 of the Revised Code to specifically declare that same-sex marriages are against the strong public policy of the state, to declare that the recognition or extension of the specific statutory benefits of legal marriage to nonmarital relationships is against the public policy of the state, and to make other declarations regarding same-sex marriages.

Said bills were considered the first time.
