INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 289-Representatives Hollister, J. Stewart, Kearns, Reidelbach, Setzer.

To enact section 4928.70 of the Revised Code to affirm December 31, 2005, as the termination date for the market development period of an incumbent electric utility for all its customer classes, except as authorized by current law; and to declare an emergency.

H. B. No. 290-Representatives Wolpert, Seitz, Martin, DePiero, Carano, D. Evans, Boccieri, Ujvagi, Beatty, Allen.

To amend sections 184.02 and 3345.32 and to enact sections 184.04, 184.05, 184.06, 184.07, 184.08, and 184.09 of the Revised Code to establish a forgivable loan program for graduate students at public and private colleges and universities in Ohio who are pursuing degrees related to the goals of the Third Frontier and who accept employment in Ohio in careers related to the goals of the Third Frontier following receipt of a master's or doctorate degree.

H. B. No. 291-Representatives DeBose, Skindell, Price, Ujvagi, Yates, Miller, Domenick, Key, Cirelli, Sykes, Beatty, Allen.

To amend section 4111.02 of the Revised Code to increase the state minimum wage.

Said bills were considered the first time.
