INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 292-Representative Oelslager.

To amend sections 1701.76 and 1701.82 and to enact sections 2307.91 to 2307.97 of the Revised Code to establish minimum medical requirements for filing certain asbestos claims and to establish limitations on successor asbestos-related liabilities relating to corporations.

H. B. No. 293-Representatives Book, Seaver.

To enact section 3704.121 of the Revised Code to require all diesel powered vehicles that are owned by the state or its political subdivisions to operate exclusively using biodiesel fuel beginning June 1, 2005, and to require all diesel fuel sold in or imported into the state to contain at least five per cent biodiesel beginning June 1, 2006.

Said bills were considered the first time.
