INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 560-Representatives Hagan, Hollister, Kearns, Schmidt, Webster, C. Evans, Carano, Harwood, Otterman, Chandler, Beatty, Strahorn.

To enact section 3721.041 of the Revised Code to require nursing homes and other homes for the elderly to offer residents vaccinations against influenza and pneumonia.

H. B. No. 561-Representative Sferra.

To amend sections 2923.122, 2923.124, 2923.126, and 2923.1212 of the Revised Code to permit political subdivisions to prohibit the carrying of concealed handguns in any park, swimming pool, sports field, or other outdoor premises or property owned, leased, or otherwise under the control of the political subdivision.

Said bills were considered the first time.

On motion of Representative Schlichter, the House adjourned until Thursday, October 7, 2004 at 11:00 o'clock a.m.
