INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 564-Representatives D. Stewart, Skindell.

To amend section 4111.03 of the Revised Code to specify that certain overtime rules adopted by the United States Secretary of Labor do not apply to employers and employees who are governed by Ohio's minimum wage and overtime law.

H. B. No. 565-Representatives Hughes, DeGeeter.

To enact section 2921.53 of the Revised Code to prohibit the unlawful sale or purchase of a peace officer badge or uniform.

Said bills were considered the first time.
