**INTRODUCTION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 570**-Representative Niehaus.

To enact section 5533.81 of the Revised Code to designate State Route 756 within Brown and Clermont counties as the "Ohio Army National Guard 216th Engineering Battalion Memorial Highway."

**H. B. No. 571**-Representative Clancy.

To amend section 5122.10 of the Revised Code to permit a licensed professional clinical counselor to take certain persons into custody and transport those persons to a hospital.

Said bills were considered the first time.
