INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

To amend sections 4765.05 and 4765.11 and to enact sections 4765.101, 4765.111, 4765.112, 4765.113, 4765.114, 4765.115, and 4765.116 of the Revised Code concerning geographic regions for provision of prehospital emergency medical services and the authority of the State Board of Emergency Medical Services to suspend certificates to practice emergency medical services.
