To enact section 5111.89 of the Revised Code to allow a Medicaid recipient eligible for home and community-based services and hospice services to receive the services concurrently.

**H. B. No. 328**-Representatives Olman, Perry, Brown.

To enact section 5533.62 of the Revised Code to name the new Interstate Route 280 bridge spanning the Maumee River in Lucas County the "Veterans' Glass City Skyway."
