### INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 583**-Representative Callender.

To amend sections 4507.50 and 4507.52 of the Revised Code to provide for the issuance of state identification cards at no charge to Medicaid recipients.

**H. B. No. 584**-Representatives Ujvagi, Carano, Cirelli, Seitz, Woodard, S. Patton, Perry, Redfern, Distel, Kearns, Allen, Hollister.

To amend sections 5747.08 and 5747.98 and to enact section 5747.72 of the Revised Code to create a refundable tax credit for nurses who teach nursing at postsecondary educational institutions and to declare an emergency.

**H. B. No. 585**-Representative Hoops.

To amend sections 2929.20, 2967.01, 2967.03, 2967.12, and 2967.26 and to enact section 5120.66 of the Revised Code to require the Department of Rehabilitation and Correction to establish and operate an Internet database that contains specified offense, sentence, and release information for each inmate serving a prison term for certain designated violence-related or sex-related offenses; to grant any person a right to submit a written statement regarding certain possible releases or transfers of any such inmate; to require the judge or the Adult Parole Authority to consider any such statement prior to granting or recommending the release or transfer for any such inmate; and to specify that these provisions are to be known as "Laura's Law."

Said bills were considered the first time.
