### INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 352**-Representatives T. Patton, Kearns.

To enact section 109.70 of the Revised Code to require the Superintendent of the Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation to establish a database of incident reports related to the improper discharge of a firearm.

**H. B. No. 353**-Representatives Young, Hagan, Seitz, Williams, Willamowski, Schaffer, Gibbs, Webster, Hoops, Fessler, Trakas, Callender, Reidelbach, Wagner, Widener, Hartnett, Aslanides, Barrett, Distel, Niehaus, J. Stewart, Brinkman, Faber, Latta, Olman, Gilb, Raussen, Schneider.

To amend section 4123.34 of the Revised Code to specify that the State Insurance Fund is considered solvent when it is funded at ninety percent of the amount calculated to fully fund the State Insurance Fund.

**H. B. No. 354**-Representatives Harwood, Cirelli, Allen, Collier, Seitz, Hartnett, Kearns, Ujvagi, Sferra, Brown, Barrett, Carano, Book.

To amend sections 2151.23, 2151.56, 2151.57, 2151.58, 2151.59, 2151.60, and 2151.61 of the Revised Code to enter into the Interstate Compact for Juveniles.

Said bills were considered the first time.
