INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced:

H. B. No. 464-Representative Redfern.

To amend sections 3335.02, 3337.01, 3339.01, 3341.02, 3343.02, 3344.01, 3352.01, 3354.05, 3355.04, 3356.01, 3357.05, 3358.03, 3359.01, 3360.01, 3361.01, 3362.01, 3517.13, 3517.151, and 3517.992 of the Revised Code to prohibit an individual from being appointed to any public college or university board of trustees if the individual has made a contribution to the holder of or to a candidate for a statewide office, to a member of or to a candidate for the office of member of the General Assembly, or to a state or county political party during the previous twelve months and to prohibit a member of a board of trustees of a public college or university from making contributions to those recipients while a member of that board and for twelve months thereafter.

Said bill was considered the first time.

CLERK'S NOTATION

In accordance with the provisions of Article II, Section 1 b, of the Ohio Constitution, the Secretary of State has transmitted to my office, on December 28, 2005, a petition seeking to initiate a statute entitled "The Smoke Free Workplace Act." This petition contains the required number of valid signatures as certified by the Secretary of State, which warrants the filing of said proposed law with the General Assembly.
