INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 547-Representative Patton, T..

To amend section 3750.20 and to enact section 3750.23 of the Revised Code to require rail owners and operators to secure rail facilities and equipment from the threat of terrorism through the development of a vulnerability assessment, an infrastructure protection program, and proper communication with public authorities and to provide civil penalties for noncompliance by a rail owner or operator.

H. B. No. 548-Representatives Hughes, Fende, Yuko, Cassell, McGregor, R., Evans, D., Latta, Williams, Widener.

To amend sections 5747.98 and 5751.98 and to enact sections 3333.51, 5747.81, 5747.82, 5751.54, and 5751.55 of the Revised Code to grant tax credits to businesses that provide internships to students attending Ohio's colleges and universities and that hire former interns.

Said bills were considered the first time.
