To amend sections 2907.08 and 2950.07 of the Revised Code to make spying or eavesdropping upon a minor in a state of nudity for the purpose of sexual gratification or arousal a felony of the fifth degree and to eliminate misdemeanor of the first degree under all circumstances.

Said bill was considered the first time.
