INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 612-Representatives Latta, Wagoner, Law, Setzer, Combs, Hartnett, Evans, C., Evans, D., Gilb, Schaffer, Webster, Hagan.

To amend sections 2903.06, 2903.08, 2903.11, 2923.02, 4507.08, 4510.13, and 4510.54 and to enact section 4510.18 of the Revised Code to require a court to impose a lifetime driver's license suspension for attempted murder by means of a motor vehicle, felonious assault using a motor vehicle, and aggravated vehicular homicide and vehicular homicide under certain circumstances; to permit a court to impose a lifetime driver's license suspension for aggravated vehicular assault; and to establish that driving under these specified lifetime suspensions is a felony of the third degree.

H. B. No. 613-Representatives Williams, DeGeeter, Distel, Allen, Yuko, Otterman, Stewart, D., Fende, Beatty, Strahorn.

To amend sections 959.99 and 2152.19 of the Revised Code to increase certain penalties for cruelty to animals and to require a child under fifteen years of age who commits cruelty against a companion animal to undergo psychological counseling.

H. B. No. 614-Representatives Chandler, DeGeeter, Williams, Skindell, Barrett, Cassell, Distel, Otterman, Foley, Woodard, Carano, Yuko, Domenick, Sayre, Perry, Brown.

To amend section 4511.81 of the Revised Code to eliminate the prohibition against using violations of the motor vehicle Child Restraint Law in criminal proceedings.

Said bills were considered the first time.
