**INTRODUCTION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 615**-Representative Book.

To enact section 5.074 of the Revised Code to designate the Great Serpent Mound as the official effigy mound of the state.

**H. B. No. 616**-Representative Gibbs.

To amend sections 5731.02, 5731.18, 5731.181, 5731.19, 5747.01, 5747.02, 5747.055, and 5748.01 of the Revised Code to terminate Ohio estate taxes; to reduce the income tax rate on retirement income, investment income, and passive business income of individuals 65 years of age or older; and to reduce the income tax rate on capital gains of all individuals having capital gain income.

Said bills were considered the first time.
