INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 623-Representative Collier.

To amend sections 4123.56 and 4123.58 of the Revised Code to allow an employee to receive temporary total disability compensation or permanent total disability compensation regardless of that employee's appointment or election to a part-time public office if specified conditions are met.

H. B. No. 624-Representative Stewart, J..

To enact section 1349.52 of the Revised Code to allow a consumer to place a security freeze on the consumer's credit report.

H. B. No. 625-Representatives Boccieri, Wolpert, McGregor, J., Skindell, Seitz, Carano, Yuko, Koziura, Brown, Perry, Fende, Evans, C., Aslanides, Hood.

To amend sections 122.16, 5733.01, 5733.98, 5747.32, 5747.98, 5751.01, and 5751.98 and to enact sections 3745.15, 3745.16, 3745.17, 5733.58, 5747.71, 5751.54, and 5751.55 of the Revised Code to promote the production of alternative fuels, the application of clean coal energy generation methods, and the redevelopment of brownfield sites by granting tax incentives for those activities and by expediting the environmental permit approval process for the construction of certain facilities on brownfield sites.

H. B. No. 626-Representative Calvert.

To amend sections 5747.01 and 5747.02 of the Revised Code to reduce the income tax rate on capital gains.

Said bills were considered the first time.
