INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 642-Representative Law.

To enact sections 3718.30 to 3718.34 of the Revised Code to establish the Household Sewage Treatment System Revolving Loan Program in the Department of Health to provide loans to low- and moderate-income persons for repairs to or upgrades of household sewage treatment systems, and to make an appropriation.

H. B. No. 643-Representatives Distel, Hartnett, Foley, DeGeeter, Chandler, Fende, Williams, Perry, Koziura, Ujvagi, Otterman.

To enact sections 1534.01 to 1534.14 and 1534.99 of the Revised Code to require persons who possess dangerous wild animals or exotic animals to obtain a personal possession permit and to establish requirements regarding the possession and care of dangerous wild animals and exotic animals.

No. 644-Representatives Carano, Domenick, DeGeeter, Fende, Evans, C., Allen, Perry, Ujvagi, Patton, S., Setzer, Chandler, Yuko, Hughes, Smith, S., Combs, DeBose, Seitz, Driehaus, Otterman, Boccieri, Mason, Latta, Reidelbach, Woodard, Skindell, Strahorn, Beatty, Foley, Barrett, Book, Stewart, D., Sayre, Oelslager, Williams.

To enact section 5.2236 of the Revised Code to designate November as "Epilepsy Awareness Month."

H. B. No. 645-Representatives Hartnett, Seitz, McGregor, J., Fende, Distel, Widowfield, Evans, D., Combs, Perry, Brown, Barrett, Foley, Widener, Latta, Boccieri, Patton, S., Woodard, Beatty.

To amend section 4503.18 of the Revised Code to allow United States veterans service organizations to register vehicles used solely for participation in organizational activities, exhibitions, and parades without the payment of

any registration fee or service fee.

Said bills were considered the first time.
