## INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 650**-Representatives Setzer, Reidelbach, Law, McGregor, J., Uecker, Seitz, Fessler, Williams, Wagner, McGregor, R..

To prohibit the Director of Agriculture from engaging in any enforcement actions against certain holders of a milk producer license until H.B. 534 of the 126th General Assembly is signed by the Governor and becomes law or January 1, 2007, whichever occurs first.

**H. B. No. 651**-Representatives McGregor, R., Flowers, Hughes, White, D., Harwood, Fende, Martin, Schaffer, Wagoner, Evans, C., Widener, McGregor, J., Uecker, Distel, Perry.

To amend sections 319.202, 323.152, 323.153, 323.154, 4503.06, 4503.064, 4503.065, 4503.066, and 4503.067 of the Revised Code to freeze the taxes on primary residences owned and occupied by low-income persons age 65 or older.

Said bills were considered the first time.

On motion of Representative McGregor, J., the House adjourned until Tuesday, September 5, 2006 at 11:00 o'clock a.m.
