INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 666-Representatives Schaffer, Trakas, Widener, Taylor, Law, Collier, Smith, G..

To amend sections 2967.16 and 2967.17 of the Revised Code to provide that a person's privilege of holding an office of honor, trust, or profit that is forfeited by reason of the person's conviction of a felony is not restored upon the person's completion of a prison term or period of community control sanctions or upon the grant of a conditional pardon or a final release by the adult parole authority.

H. B. No. 667-Representatives Hughes, Setzer, Cassell, Williams, Willamowski, Yuko, Latta, Fende, Chandler, Collier, Smith, S., Skindell, Law, Barrett, Wagoner, Wolpert, Harwood, Bocchieri, Hartnett, Evans, D., Strahorn.

To enact section 5501.70 of the Revised Code to require the Director of Transportation to designate a portion of a state highway as a memorial highway in honor of every state highway patrol trooper who is or has been killed in the line of duty.

H. B. No. 668-Representatives Widener, McGregor, R..

To enact section 5533.791 of the Revised Code to designate State Route 334 in Clark County as the "Lance Cpl. Kevin S. Smith Memorial Highway."

Said bills were considered the first time.
