INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced:

H. B. No. 678-Representatives Foley, Skindell, Driehaus, DeGeeter, Brown, DeBose, Ujvagi, Fessler, Strahorn, Seitz, Yates.

To amend sections 2329.17, 2329.18, 2329.19, 2329.26, 2329.27, 2329.31, 2329.36, and 5309.64, and to enact section 2329.271 of the Revised Code to require purchasers of real property at a judicial sale to provide certain identifying information, to allow municipal corporations to conduct inspections of property subject to a writ of execution, to require judicial sales to be confirmed within thirty days of sale, and to require officers who sell real property at a judicial sale to file a deed within fourteen days of confirmation.

Said bill was considered the first time.
