INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 679-Representatives Wolpert, Ujvagi, Yuko, Reidelbach, Combs.

To amend section 1901.25 of the Revised Code to provide that a board of county commissioners, upon the request of the legislative authority of a municipal court, may fix the compensation of jurors in the court in an amount that differs from the compensation of jurors in the court of common pleas.

H. B. No. 680-Representatives Evans, C., Brown, Combs, DeGeeter, Fessler, Hood, Patton, S., Perry, Seitz, Uecker.

To amend sections 2743.02 and 2744.01 and to enact section 4510.121 of the Revised Code to permit a person who is issued a ticket for operating a motor vehicle other than a commercial motor vehicle with an expired driver's or commercial driver's license to be issued a seven-day field driving permit.

H. B. No. 681-Representatives Evans, C., Combs, Fende, Hartnett, Patton, S., Perry, Seitz.

To enact section 122.681 of the Revised Code to establish the Residential Weatherization Assistance Fund to be administered by the Office of Community Services in the Department of Development for the purpose of providing weatherization assistance to certain eligible households in this state.

Said bills were considered the first time.
