INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 683-Representative Peterson.

To amend section 4731.22 and to enact sections 4731.284, 4731.45, and 4731.451 of the Revised Code to prohibit for a three-year period the performance of Transverse Rectus Abdominis Muscle (TRAM) flap procedures and to create the TRAM Flap Task Force to study the safeness and efficacy of these procedures.

H. B. No. 684-Representatives Fessler, Peterson, Reidelbach, Evans, D., Perry.

To amend sections 303.211 and 519.211 of the Revised Code relative to township and county telecommunication tower zoning authority.

H. B. No. 685-Representatives Faber, Blasdel, DeWine, Flowers, Seitz, Carmichael, Evans, C., Peterson, Daniels, Raussen, Raga.

To amend sections 101.35, 103.0511, 111.15, 119.03, 119.032, and 127.18; to enact section 101.351; and to repeal section 119.031 of the Revised Code to revise the procedures for rule-making hearings and for legislative review of proposed rules, to require agencies to pay a fee upon making filings for legislative review, and to repeal an obsolete provision for legislative review of rules upon adoption.

Said bills were considered the first time.
