INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 686-Representatives Daniels, Hartnett, Reidelbach, Patton, S., Brown, Combs, Uecker, Seitz, White, D., McGregor, J., Setzer.

To amend section 3901.386 of the Revised Code to require insurers and other third-party payers to accept and honor assignment-of-benefit agreements entered into between plan beneficiaries and treating health care providers or remit payments for services rendered by those providers to beneficiaries directly.

H. B. No. 687-Representative DeGeeter.

To amend section 2913.71 of the Revised Code to provide that theft of a vehicle validation sticker is a felony of the fifth degree.

Said bills were considered the first time.
