Mr. Speaker:

I am directed to inform the House of Representatives that the Senate has passed the following bill in which the concurrence of the House is requested:

Am. Sub. S. B. No. 5 - Senators Hottinger, Harris

To amend sections 1731.01, 1731.03, 1731.04, 1731.09, 2921.01, 3924.04, and 3924.06 and to enact sections 3923.81 and 3961.01 to 3961.09 of the Revised Code to regulate discount medical plan organizations concerning provider agreements and marketing, disclosure, cancellation, and refund requirements; to make changes to the Small Employer Health Care Alliances Law and the Small Employer Health Benefit Plans Law; and to limit the amount of copayments and deductibles paid by persons insured by health benefit plans.

I am directed to inform the House of Representatives that the Senate has concurred in the passage of the following bill:

Senators Goodman, Harris, Miller, D., Schuler

To enact section 2109.361 of the Revised Code to require the probate court, upon application by an affected beneficiary, to determine the fairness of an

agreement requiring a fiduciary or beneficiary to pay a percentage of an inheritance or a dollar amount to any person other than the beneficiary and to allow the probate court to approve, modify, or disapprove the agreement.
