**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

**S. B. No. 279**-Senators Stivers, Cates, Spada.

To amend sections 3955.01 and 3955.12 of the Revised Code to exempt the Ohio Insurance Guaranty Association from being obligated to pay more than a single three hundred thousand dollar claim for injury or death to any one person and a claim of an insured whose net worth exceeds fifty million dollars.

**S. B. No. 280**-Senators Schuring, Jordan, Armbruster, Gardner, Stivers, Carey, Grendell, Padgett, Fingerhut, Miller, R., Zurz, Clancy, Austria.

To enact section 4503.433 of the Revised Code to authorize the display of combat battle stars on certain special combat or military license plates.

**S. B. No. 281**-Senators Stivers, Padgett, Mumper, Goodman, Austria, Spada.

To amend sections 109.761 and 109.802, to enact new section 109.803, and to repeal section 109.803 of the Revised Code to mandate up to 24 hours a year of continuing professional training for peace officers and state highway patrol troopers and to establish the method by which the Attorney General reimburses the training costs.

To amend sections 148.04, 148.06, 305.11, 504.11, 505.375, 505.391, 505.94, 515.01, and 5705.10 and to enact section 504.021 of the Revised Code to make changes in various laws pertaining to townships, to permit written distribution of records, in lieu of reading the previous proceedings' record, at a session of the board of county commissioners, and to permit townships and municipal corporations to directly form fire and ambulance districts.
