INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 310-Senator Stivers.

To amend sections 5747.01, 5747.02, 5747.05, 5747.08, and 5747.98 and to repeal section 5747.055 of the Revised Code to exempt from the personal income tax any unearned income of an individual who is age sixty-five or older.

S. B. No. 311-Senators Gardner, Padgett, Harris, Clancy, Mumper.

To amend sections 3301.42, 3313.603, 3313.61, 3313.615, 3314.012, 3314.03, 3325.08, and 3345.06 and to enact sections 3301.0713, 3302.032, 3313.6013, 3319.233, 3333.163, 3333.34, and 3345.061 of the Revised Code to establish the Ohio Core curriculum, to restructure admission requirements and remedial courses in state universities, and to implement other initiatives to enhance secondary and post-secondary education in Ohio.

S. B. No. 312-Senators Dann, Miller, D..

To amend section 4513.03 of the Revised Code to require the headlights of a vehicle to be lighted when its windshield wipers are in use.
