OFFERING OF RESOLUTIONS

Senator Coughlin offered the following joint resolution:

S. J. R. No. 9-Senators Coughlin, Cates.

Proposing to amend Section 2a of Article XII and to enact Section 2b of Article XII of the Constitution of the State of Ohio to limit increases in the taxable value of real property to two per cent per year.

The question being, "Shall the joint resolution, **S. J. R. No. 9**, be adopted?"

On the motion of Senator Schuler, **S. J. R. No. 9**, was referred to the Committee on Reference.

Senator Cates offered the following concurrent resolution:

S. C. R. No. 31-Senators Cates, Harris, Gardner, Jacobson, Goodman, Wachtmann, Hottinger, Niehaus, Carey, Schuler, Armbruster, Coughlin, Clancy, Miller, D., Jordan, Austria.

To designate August 18, 2006, as "Joe Nuxhall Day" in Ohio.

WHEREAS, Joe Nuxhall was born in Hamilton, Ohio, and was a student at Hamilton High School when he signed a major league baseball contract with the Cincinnati Reds; and

WHEREAS, Joe Nuxhall was fifteen years old when he made his major league debut for the Cincinnati Reds on June 10, 1944, thus becoming the youngest player to appear in a major league game, a distinction that is his yet today; and

WHEREAS, Shortly before the start of the 1967 season Joe Nuxhall retired from baseball and became one of the Reds' primary radio broadcast announcers, a position he held for thirty-eight years until the end of the 2004 season; and

WHEREAS, During his tenure as a Reds announcer, Joe Nuxhall was much beloved by Cincinnati Reds fans young and old alike for his endearingly folksy style, and he and longtime announcing partner Marty Brennaman transcended baseball to become living legends and their broadcast team a

Cincinnati institution; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That we, the members of the 126th General Assembly of the State of Ohio, hereby designate August 18, 2006, as "Joe Nuxhall Day" in Ohio and encourage not only Cincinnati Reds fans but all Ohio baseball fans to salute Joe Nuxhall for his love of baseball and the Cincinnati Reds, for his devotion to his family and fans, and for his charity work in the Greater Cincinnati area through the Joe Nuxhall Scholarship Fund and the Joe Nuxhall Character Education Fund; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Senate transmit duly authenticated copies of this resolution to Joe Nuxhall and to the news media of Ohio.
