To amend sections 4731.091, 4731.14, and 4731.281 and to enact sections 4731.093 and 4731.284 of the Revised Code to require instruction in cultural competency to qualify to obtain or renew a certificate of registration to practice medicine and surgery or osteopathic medicine and surgery.
